



RIDER RULES

PASSENGER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

1. Listen for the bell, which signals the beginning and end of a ride.
2. Riders shall only enter and exit the ride through designated gate areas.
3. Children less than 42" tall ride free but must be accompanied by a competent companion with a token.
4. Companion may assist only one rider at a time.
5. Companion must remain standing on the inside of the figure.
6. Only one rider per carousel figure, except for the companion with child under 42".
7. Riders should not exceed a weight of 225 lbs. for each jumping figure or 275 lbs. for each standing figure.
8. Each chariot passenger should not exceed a weight of 325 lbs.
9. No food or beverage are allowed on the Carousel ride.
10. Riders must remain facing forward during the ride with one leg on each side of the figure – No side saddle riding!
11. Riders may not move about during the ride.
12. Riders are not allowed in the "Pit" area.
13. If riders become unruly, the Operator will stop the ride. Unruly riders will have to exit the ride at the discretion of the Operator without question.
14. Riders are not permitted to ride the Carousel if they are under the influence of illegal drugs, prescription drugs, alcohol, marijuana, or any substance that impairs coordination, balance, or perception.
15. All riders must wear proper footwear, which includes a full sole. No shoes with tall, thin raised heels.
16. All riders must exit the carousel and return to the entry line if they wish to ride the Carousel again.
17. The operator has the right to refuse any member of the public admission to the ride if, in the opinion of the Operator, the passenger's bearing or conduct will endanger themselves or other members of the public, or if the passenger's health or physical condition makes it unsafe for them to use the ride. Patrons have a duty to not ride the Carousel if they are under the influence of drugs or alcohol or are otherwise impaired.
18. There are inherent risks in using the Carousel and, by riding it, patrons accept the inherent risks of which the ordinary prudent person is or should be aware. Patrons have a duty to exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner while using the Carousel, and to obey all oral or written warnings, or both, prior to or during participation, or both.
19. Patrons have a duty to properly use all Carousel safety equipment provided.
20. Patrons must report any incident, accident, or injury to the Carousel Management Office next to the token machines and complete an incident report. First aid kits are located at the Carousel Management Office and at the Operator's Booth.
